Early Bird

Deadline: **JUNE 17, 2008** – entries postmarked on or before June 17 will receive \$10.00 off first event

Deadline: **JULY 3, 2008.** All entries must be postmarked by USPS no later than July 3, 2008. Any entries postmarked after this date will only be accepted by decision of the competition committee and may be subject to a late entry fee. Requests for changes in events after the deadline may be subject to a \$20 fee.

Test Level/Age: Test level and age are as of the deadline date of July 3, 2008. Skaters have the option of skating up one level

Entry Fees: All applications must be accompanied by the correct entry fees.

Pairs: \$60 per pair per event

Risk Assumption: In accordance with rule 3222

Refunds: Cancellation of an event will be the only reason for a refund. See note at bottom of page and rule 3235.

Music: **CD's only -NO paper labels.** Please bring an extra copy as a back-up.

Medals: Medals will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places winners.

Governing Rules: The 2008 Official US Figure Skating Rulebook for all events except Short Programs which will use 2008-2009 Rules.

Rink: The rink measures 185' X 85' feet with rounded corners.

Schedules: **PLEASE NOTE:** If you wish to receive a confirmation by mail, please enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope with your application. Otherwise, the schedule will be posted on our website www.smithfieldfsc.org. Please do not call for schedule. Practice ice information will also be made available once the schedule is set.

Judging: The **IJS Judging System** will be used for Short Programs Intermediate through Senior and Free skating events at the Juvenile through Senior levels.

SHOWCASE

Levels: Pre-Preliminary, Preliminary, Pre-Juvenile, Juvenile, Intermediate and Adult Showcase.

Skaters may skate up one level. Props used by the skater must be able to be carried on and off the ice quickly by the skater. Time limit: 1:30 to 2:30. Males and Females may be combined to accommodate all entrants at the discretion of the committee. Skaters will be judged on the following criteria: Originality, Costume, Choreography, technical merit and audience appeal.
